

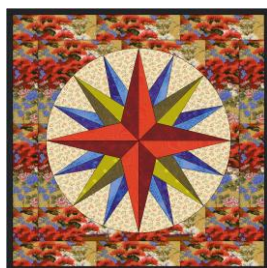
## **Foundation Piecing For Absolute Beginners workshop**

When: Saturday, March 26th, 2011

9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Where: Lyne Village Hall, Lyne Lane, Lyne nr Chertsey, KT16 0AN

During this day-long workshop you will be learning the fundamentals of foundation paper piecing from small simple blocks to larger more complex blocks. You will be given three patterns to work from, Little Village, Mariner's Compass, and Dino Tracks.



**Fabric needed:** You will only need small quantities of fabrics, so no need to buy more than a fat quarter of any one fabric, but the trick is to have enough variety in your fabric selection. At a minimum I suggest you have enough fabric choice for the **Mariner's Compass Block** to hand on the day, and use the same fabric for the other blocks: You will need **two tones each of three different colours and a contrasting background fabric, so seven fabrics in all** ( e.g.- two red fabrics - one dark, one medium value; two green fabrics - dark and medium; two blue fabrics - dark and medium; and one light value cream fabric for the background). All fabrics should be solids, tone-on-tone, or very small prints, and should have a high degree of contrast between each other. This is because the pieces in the blocks may end up being relatively small in the finished blocks. I will be bringing a small stash of fabrics with me to share on the day if needed to supplement your fabric selection, as well as the foundation papers you will be needing.

**Other supplies needed:** Your sewing machine; your sewing kit (scissors, needles, pins, thread, etc); rotary cutting equipment; small iron (if you have one); extension lead; and of course your lunch and coffee mug!
